

# Quarterly AMP Data File Submission Structure

Labeler Code	5	1-5	NDC segment #1
Product Code	4	6-9	NDC segment #2
Package Size Code	2	10-11	NDC segment #3
Year / Quarter	5	12-16	YYYYQ
Average Mfgr Price	13	17-29	999999.999999

**IMPORTANT:** Report must be delivered as a flat file as specified above, with a new row for each NDC (see sample under *File Format*).

## Field Definitions:

Labeler Code	First segment of the National Drug Code (NDC1) that identifies the manufacturer, labeler, re-labeler, packager, re-packager, or distributor of the drug.
Product Code	Second segment of the NDC
Package Size Code	Third segment of the NDC
Quarter / Year	The quarter and year of the Average Manufacturer Price (AMP) being delivered to the State.
Average Manufacturer Price (AMP)	The AMP per-unit per-product code. ONLY for the Quarter / year covered, based on sales. If a drug is distributed in multiple package sizes, there will be one "weighed" AMP for the product, which will be the same for all package sizes.

## File Format:

- AMP data is to be delivered in an ASCII fixed-length text file. Proprietary formats (ie, Excel sheets) are **not** acceptable.
- Data must be set up positionally as described in the table at the beginning of this document. In other words, positions 1 through 5 are labeler code, positions 6 through 9 are product code, etc.
- Carriage returns are to be used as the line terminator.
- Example:

0006942003020081000002.654321  
0006942103020081000003.123456

## AMP Pricing Methodology:

When reporting the AMP, manufacturers must also include a summary of its pricing methodology. The State accepts the standards of the national drug rebate agreement entered into by the federal Department of Health and Human Services and Section 1927 of the Social Security Act, 42 United States Code, Section 1396r-8(c)(1)(C) for reporting pricing.
